Areas of Responsibility:

Major Goals and Objectives

- ∞ Ensure the safety of staff and visitors while on the Foundation's properties and promote the Foundation's reputation of hospitality when interacting with guests
- ∞ Perform grounds duties in a manner that does not interfere with programming events
- ∞ Be proactive in upkeep of grounds and facilities

Requisite and Preferred Qualifications

- ∞ Ability to lift 50 pounds, to stoop or bend over for extended periods, to climb ladders, and to crawl on hands and knees
- ∞ Valid driver's license
- ∞ Ability to pass a background check in the areas of sexual offenses and driving records, as well as to pass a drug test
- ∞ Knowledge of small machinery, mowers, and tools
- ∞ Basic knowledge of grounds maintenance and gardening (some past work experience preferred)
